## Standard First Aid with CPR/AED—Adult

Handling emergency situations, breathing and cardiac emergencies, adult CPR, basic precautions for preventing disease transmission, identifying and caring for life-threatening bleeding, sudden illness and injuries. How to use an AED for victims of sudden cardiac arrest. Meets OSHA Guidelines for First Aid.

## CPR—Infant and Child

Preventing, recognizing and providing basic care for breathing and cardiac emergencies in infants and children under the age of 12 until advanced medical help can take over. Basic precautions for preventing disease transmission. Includes child AED training.
