

NEBRASKA STATE YOUTH CHAMPIONSHIPS

Fremont, Nebraska

WHEN: March 6, 7 and 8, 2009

WHO: Boys and girls in 4th, 5th, 6th, 7th, 8th and 9th grades

ENTRY FEE: \$125 (three games guaranteed)

WHERE: Fremont, Nebraska – various sites throughout the city

RULES: • NSAA high school rules

- Two 20-minute halves with running clock and five minute half-time
- Two full-time outs per half – no carry-over
- Overtime – two minutes



BRACKETS – Up to eight teams will be placed in each bracket. Placement will be based on the coach's rating. (Each team is **GUARANTEED THREE GAMES**). Most grades, if not all, will have multiple brackets. Teams of any level of ability are **WELCOME!** Although not likely, we do reserve the right to combine grades to fill divisions.

PLAYERS – Players must compete in their own grade classification. Exception – younger players may participate in an older division. Players can only play on one team per grade and cannot play down. Violations of this may render a player and /or teams ineligible.

ENTRANCE FEE – Registration fee per team is \$125 for up to 10 players. For each additional player, add \$5. Each team must pay with one check payable to Fremont Family YMCA.

ENTRY DEADLINE – Deadline to enter is February 13, 2009 (or sooner if full). We will accept no change in player rosters after deadline. We will not guarantee placement by phone. We must have your check, roster and all required information. We reserve the right to refuse the entrance of any team.

MEDALS and AWARDS – In eight-team brackets, medals will be awarded to each player on teams who win first, second and third. Medals will be awarded to the top half of the teams in brackets with less than eight teams.

SCOREKEEPERS / OFFICIALS – Each team must provide one scorekeeper and/or one bookkeeper for each game. (Please make sure they are 16-years-old or older). Officials will be NSAA registered.

RULES – Games will consist of two 20-minute halves. Clock stops last one minute of each half and on timeouts reported by referee. Women's size ball will be used for all divisions except 9th grade boys. The official chooses which team's ball will be used as the game ball. A team cannot full court press once they have a lead of 20 points or more.

ADMISSION – Daily admission will be charged at all game sites. Passes for two coaches and player passes will be provided. All others will be charged admission.

NOTIFICATION – You will be notified via email (provided your email address is included with your team registration form) when we receive your registration. Schedules will be emailed Friday, February 27. Team packets and passes will be handed out when you check in prior to your first game.
